

LOUTH PHOTOGRAPHIC SOCIETY COMPETITIONS

CLUB COMPETITIONS

Slide Competitions - 3 slides on a set subject and usually 3 slides for an open competition. Entries on the night. Totals are added up at the end of the year (May) and the winner receives a trophy.

Print Competitions - No more than 3 prints. Competitions are usually held every two months. A trophy is awarded as before. Digital camera prints are held in conjunction with the monthly slide competitions - 3 prints on any subject i.e. Open. A trophy is awarded.

Local Assignments - These are usually in conjunction with the Print Competition above and consist of 3 slides or prints on a set "local" subject within 15 miles of Louth.

Slide of the Year - held in November and judged by an outside judge. No more than 6 slides in total with a maximum of 3 in each of the following categories:

Pictorial

Record

Natural History

Portrait

Photojournalism (sport can be included)

Landscape

A trophy is awarded for the winner in each category and the overall "slide of the year"

Print of the Year - held in November/December and judged by an outside judge. No more than 6 prints in total with a maximum of 3 in each of the following categories:

Pictorial

Record

Natural History

Portrait

Landscape

A trophy is awarded for each category as well as trophies for Print of the Year, and Monochrome.

LINCOLNSHIRE COMPETITIONS

Photographer of the Year (Poty) This competition takes place in November and individual prints, no larger than 18" x 12" and/or slides are judged by a judge from outside the county. Prizes - trophies and commendation certificates. Entries to be submitted at the Battle Finals in October. The categories are usually: Pictorial, Record, Natural History, Abstract and Photojournalism.

Travelling Portfolio - Individuals may submit prints and slides to the L.P.A. (Lincolnshire Photographic Association) by December. The portfolios are sent round to LPA Clubs for judging during the winter months.

LPA Battles - each club submits 9 slides and 9 prints to be judged in competition with other clubs throughout the summer months (May, June, July). There are 3 preliminary rounds and the winners take part in the finals in October. Prizes - trophies of the winning club and the runner up.

Foster Challenge - this competition takes place in April at Horncastle Camera Club. Clubs are invited to submit 5 prints with no more than 3 from an individual member.
